

The University of Missouri's Sex Discrimination, Sexual Harassment and Sexual Misconduct in Education/Employment Policy [Section 600.020 of the Collected Rules and Regulations] requires, with some exceptions, that all University employees (faculty, staff, RAs and student employees (for information they learn while in the role of student employee)) report to the Title IX Coordinator any known, learned or rumored incidents of sex discrimination, including: sexual harassment, sexual misconduct, stalking on the basis of sex, dating/intimate partner violence or sexual exploitation and/or related experiences or incidents. Reporting of such information is required, **regardless** of whether that information was shared in person, via e-mail, and/or in classroom papers or homework assignments.
